Awards WA is proud to be able to offer both The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award and youth Ignite Award.

With reference to The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, it is the world's leading youth-development program for young people. It is voluntary, non-competitive and available to anyone aged 13-24.

The Award is about individual challenge, rather than reaching specific standards set by others. Young people design their own Award program, set their own goals, and record their own progress. They choose a Service, Physical Recreation and Skills activity, go on an Adventurous Journey and, to achieve a Gold Award (the highest level), take part in a Residential Project. There are three progressive levels which when successfully completed, lead to a Bronze, Silver or Gold Award. The only person they compete against is themselves, by challenging their own beliefs about what they can achieve. Over eight million young people have participated in the Award since it began in 1956 and many millions more have felt its impact in their communities.

Recently, we have introduced our new program – Ignite Award – of discovery for 10 – 14 year olds providing a framework to learning valuable skills, assisting others in the community, being active and experiencing adventures.
